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ANNUAL REPORT 2025-26

Shree Maruthi Residential School and PU College (SMRS & PUC), Bangaramakki, affiliated to CBSE, was established in 2010 with the motto "*Knowledge is Strength*" to cater the holistic development of the students of rural areas in the Uttara Kannada District envisioned by *Shri Shri Shri Maruthi Guruji*.

Adding one more significant feather to the SMRS cap, the school was upgraded to the **higher secondary level-Pre-University College in 2023, the first ever PUC of CBSE curriculum in the entire Uttara Kannada district and the neighbouring districts to enable the students to study in one campus from nursery to grade XII.**

For the academic year 2025-26, we have 324 **Students** of whom **190 boys** and **134 girls**, with **27 Teachers** and **17 Supporting Staff**. At this juncture, on behalf of the management, I would like to congratulate and thank **Mr.Vinayak Naik** PTA Vice-president and **Mr.Vishnumurthy Hedge** PTA Secretary, other PTA members, parents, students, teachers and supporting staff for the efforts done to cross the number of students beyond 300 through their tireless positive campaigning expecting much more next year with the target taking the strength beyond 500.

The following Annual Report 2025-26 has three parts, namely, Academics, Non-academic Co-Curricular Activities and Novel Initiatives.

I. ACADEMICS:

(i) CBSE Board Exams Result 2024-25

From its inception SMRS has provided quality education which is evident from the fact that we got 100% results in CBSE Board exam of grade X and XII. **Jagdish Naik, grade XII with 87%** and **Pragna Hedge, Grade X with 89.2%** were the toppers of the College-School. It's worth-mentioning to congratulate **Jishnu Bhat, grade X scored out of out (100/100) in Kannada** and **subject teacher Mr.Manjunath Gouda**. The first batch of grade XII – PU College secured 100% result under CBSE.

These above academic result speak volumes regarding SMRS & PU College and its commitment to impart quality education.

(ii) 'The main thing is to keep the main thing as the main thing' as the schools are the temples of learning. The regular academic classes of teaching-learning with regular Class tests, Slip tests, Oral exams, Written exams, Periodic tests, Mid-term exams, Annual Exams, Project works, Activity-oriented teaching, Subject enrichment activities, Art Integrated Learning are carried out to ensure students learn as per the CBSE-NCERT prescribed syllabus curriculum and National Education Policy 2020 and National Curriculum Framework 2023.

(iii) Smart Class Facility

Two numbers of Smart Class with internet facility is used to effectively carry out Audio-Visual supported teaching-learning activity.

(iv) NEET, JEE Coaching: Grade XII

Students of Grade XII are given a special off-line coaching of JEE, NEET by the expert trainers **Mr.Subha Krishna and Mr.Manjunatha from Mysuru** and tests are conducted regularly in view of preparing them to face the competitive exams in an easy manner.

(v) Extended Classes: Grade XII

Extended Classes are conducted for the students of Grade XII from 7:00 am – 8:15 am and 4:15 pm to 5:45 pm to ensure that the students receive the best learning with the assistance of the learned teachers.

(vi) Orientation & Training : Teachers

On-going training and orientation for the *professional development of the teaching faculty both online and offline* are regularly held throughout the year with the help of excellent master- corporate trainers: **Mr Satish**, Mysuru, **Mr. Santosh Avannavar** from Bengaluru and Mr.Kushal from Mysuru.

Teachers attend **CBSE appointed resource person offline training** at different CBSE schools of the district and the similar training will be conducted in our school on 3 January 2026 for our teachers.

(vii) Workshop : Students

Fifteen days Special workshop sessions on **Mathematical Thinking** based on Flipped Pedagogy were conducted for the students and subject teachers of Grade IV to XII by the excellent master-trainer **Mr. Santosh Avannavar, a teacher at International School, Luxemburg-Germany** in August and October.

Students' body election was held following the principles of democratic principles to instill in the students the value of active participation in the governance of the school.

Health Awareness Programmes : Dengue and HIV-AIDS were conducted inviting the health professionals for the students of Grade V – XII.

CELECT Foundation organized a **Free Eye Check-up camp** for all the students and the staff at our school; free spectacles too were distributed.

(viii) Laboratory Facilities: Computer, Physics, Chemistry & Biology

Well-equipped separate Laboratories of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Computer enable the students to have hand-on-experience with the practicals and experiments of the theory learnt in the class rooms.

(ix) Bus Facility

We are happy to inform you that SMRS & PUC has the best transport BUS facility equipped with the latest features like CCTV and Fire-Smoke alarms and Extinguishers for the safety of the students with the nominal fees.

(x) Avishkaar – Annual Exhibition

Avishkaar-Annual Exhibition was conducted on 2 December, Tuesday where the students with the help and guidance from teachers and parents exhibited different modules – projects in the matter related to Science, Mathematics, Kannada, English, Hindi, Social Science, Art and Craft where every student of SMRS & PUC actively participated.

II. CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Besides academics, holistic development of the students is the specific emphasis at SMRS & PUC. The students are divided into four houses: **Achievers, Believers, Challengers and Dreamers (ABCD)** to promote healthy inter-house Sports and Games, Literary and Cultural Competitions.

(i) Literary, Cultural Competitions

opportunities are provided to the students to participate in various school, Intra-class, Inter-class & Inter-house, Taluk, District **Literary, Cultural competitions**, namely, Drawing, Singing, Memorisation, Recitation, Speech, Speed-Reading, Handwriting, Painting, Essay Writing, Notice Board Decoration, Fancy Dress, Vegetable Carving, Quiz, Pick and Speak, Mono-acting, Classical singing, Bhagavad Gita Recitation, Street Play, News Collage, Folk Song, Elocution, Bharathanatyam etc.,

The following winning-moments need special mention:

- ✓ In **Kadamba Sahodaya School Complex Cultural Fest**, conducted at Mar Thoma Central, Honnavar, where 11 CBSE schools of North Kannada district participated and out of 40 students of SMRS participated in the various competitions: News Collage, Folk Song, Street play, Elocution, Bharathanatyam in Junior–senior categories, record making of 31 students secured medals in which 18 gold and 13 silver medals .
- ✓ **Shantivana Trust, Dharmasthala** initiated **Honnavar Taluk Level Competitions, DV Pramath Kumar V Hegde** secured 1st place in Speech; and Dhanya Gopal Naik got 2nd place in Drawing ; Dhanush R Naik secured 3rd in speech; Bhuvu V Bhat and Viranjan V Bhat got 3rd in Kantapata – recitation, 5 got prizes out of 8 students participated.
- ✓ National Level open Karate Championship held at Honnavar, Nawaz Khan grade x secured 1st prize in Kata and Kumte; Dhruva got 2nd in Kata and 3rd in Kumte; Ajay Naik got 3rd in Kata.
- ✓ Like the previous year, this year **Annual Day** too, we have ensured that **every student of SMRS & PUC**, appears on the stage this evening (tomorrow) before you to showcase his / her god-given talents.

(ii) Co-curricular Additional Skills Classes:

Every Saturday, classes on **Classical Singing, Tabla, Bharatanatyam and Karate** are held for the students to develop their additional skills under the guidance of the talented experts with nominal fees. Theory cum Practical exams are held and the grades achieved are mentioned in the students' Report Cards.

Every Saturday, Yoga, Meditation and Mass Drill are conducted for all the students to promote control over one's mind and self-awareness.

(iii) Sports & Games Facilities:

Healthy mind is possible with healthy body. **Indoor & Outdoor games and sports** are regularly organized to ensure students' health. Indoor Games like Carom, Ludo, Chess, Snake & ladder and Outdoor games, namely Volley ball, Throw ball, Kho-kho, Kabbaddi, Cricket, Badminton, Foot ball, Lagori are worth mentioning especially at our modern times when children are getting addicted to TV, Mobile and Video games.

It is worth mentioning that the **school-college got its Sports Arena** for track and field individual and group events this year and the management has an elaborate plan in developing the sports facilities to the best standard in the coming days.

Annual Sports Festival held on 13 and 14 November occupies an important activity of the academic year calendar where intra-class and inter-house sports and games were held and the winners were awarded with about 1200 Gold, Silver, Bronze medals and certificates.

There are 13 students who will be honoured later today as **individual champions** for having won 1st place in 3 individual events and the **Challengers House** as the **Champions of the Sports Festival 2024-25** for having secured the highest points.

Parents Sports Festival was conducted on 14 December, Sunday to bring students, teachers and parents closer and prizes will be distributed to the winner-parents in men, women and common category.

In the Kadamba Sahodaya School Complex Annual Sports Meet, two of our students backed silver medals: **Bhuvi V Bhat in Long Jump** under 14 and **Shrinidhi in Shot put** under 14.

III. NOVEL INITIATIVES

(i) Celebrations & Programmes

Festivals and celebrations of **State, National and International importance** were meaningfully observed and celebrated at SMRS & PUC organizing cultural programmes and competitions to instill among the students the values and the spirit attached to each of them: namely, International Yoga Day-students performing yoga, Independence Day, Teachers' Day, Hindi Diwas, a week long Kannada Rajyotsava celebrations with various competitions, Children's Day in which theme-based Fancy Dress Competitions held need a separate mention.

The 75th Birthday –**Diamond Jubilee Birthday celebration of Dr. G T Hegde** sir, the founding Principal and the present Academic Director of SMRS & PUC was meaningfully celebrated on 8 August 2025 acknowledging his enormous contribution in the growth of the school and college.

(ii) Alumni Gathering

Alumni gathering was held to have an in-depth discussion on studying in the CBSE schools till XII at SMRS & PUC. Everyone gathered there agreed that there are several advantages to continue in SMRS & PUC in Bangaramakki in an affordable fees.

(iii) Spoken English

English speaking in the school premises is made compulsory to **master and polish spoken English** among the students. The violators are given **constructive punishment** which results in positive outcome in improving the English speaking-thinking abilities among the students tremendously.

(iv) Vocabulary Building: Kannada, English, Hindi

In order to enhance the language skills, every day, one each new vocabulary-word in Kannada, English, Hindi is written on the class board with their meaning which the students copy them in their notebooks. Every month, vocabulary tests are conducted and the scores are maintained.

(v) Gift-a-Book Initiative: Birthdays

A novel initiative is introduced to instill in the minds of the young children regarding the necessity to **Book Reading** by encouraging every student to gift a book to the school library on their birthday. It is worth mentioning that this initiative received an overwhelming response from the students that some students donate more than one book. The same books are given to the students during the library period to promote a forgotten **Book Reading Habit** among the students.

(vi) One Rupee Admission

It is to remember that there is an unique offer in honour of the Silver Jubilee year Peetarohana of our President Shri Shri Shri Maruti Guruji, for the students who score 90 % and above in the grade X board exam, i.e., that they will be admitted in PUC first year with just one rupee and likewise if they continue to do well and secure the same and above in PUC first year, they will be readmitted in PUC 2nd year with just one rupee.

(vii) No Donation

SMRS & PUC receives '**No Donation**' in whatsoever form. It only charges fees, which is the lowest compared to all CBSE schools in the entire district.

To conclude, on behalf of school management, Teachers and the supporting staff, I sincerely **thank the parents** for entrusting your wards into our care, as I **thank the students** for their excellent performance in all areas of life to bring glory to SMRS & PUC, making it a sought-after-school for anyone who looks for excellent academic and character formation of their wards.
